VOCATION



"For most people... the calling of God seems to be breathed into their lives as their lives unfold. They are drawn to certain things at certain times, and the necessary doors swing open. They rarely know exactly what they are meant to achieve, but they often have the sense that they should be...

I can best describe my own sense of calling as a sense of obedience. I am aware that I can obey God, or not, and if I were to abandon what I am doing, or even change the focus, I would feel as if I were disobeying God.. Sometimes the positive, feel-good factor is completely absent, and all I have to go on is this sense of obedience, that I am following where someone else is guiding...

Being called gives purpose, vision and strength, but not always an overall or detailed view of how things will unfold".
