ELECTORAL ROLL REVISION 2016

The Flectoral Rolls for St Matthew's Harwell and All Saints' Chilton are being revised in the period 6th March to 26th March inclusive. The Electoral Roll is your Parish Church's Register of Electors, the list of those qualified to vote at the Church Annual General Meeting at which the Parochial Church Council and the Deanery Synod representatives are elected. You also need to be on the Flectoral Roll for at least 6 months. to be a PCC member or Churchwarden. If you are already on the Electoral Roll you do not need to reregister. For St Matthew's Harwell forms may be obtained from the table at the back of church, and completed forms should be placed in the wall box in church near the main door. For All Saints' Chilton forms may be obtained from Gordon Cowan (telephone 831932) or from All Saints' Church (blank forms in the red envelope at the base of the font), and completed forms should be returned to Gordon or placed in the vellow envelope at the base of the font. Forms should be returned no later than 26th March.




PRAYER FOCUS
