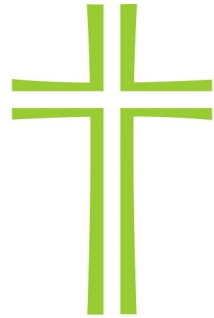

There is prayer, praise and Communion service focusing on CAP on Sunday **7th October, 6.30pm** at Didcot Baptist Church. All very welcome.

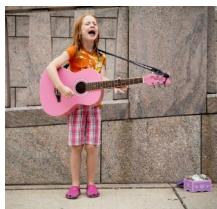

The fresh produce will be available at Harwell Village Hall for people to take for a donation to Tearfund. Please do take what you can use.

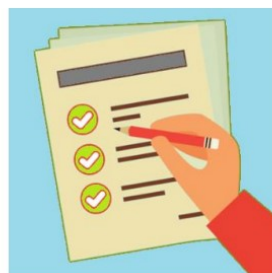
## RESEARCH PROJECT

A team of researchers from Coventry University will be attending the 11am service at Harwell on Sunday 14th October and the 9.30 service at Chilton on Sunday 28th October.

They are doing research on religious worship and social connectedness, and would be very grateful for volunteers to take part in their project.

Volunteering will involve a 'pressure cuff test' (having a cuff inflated on the arm, similar to what is done when you have your blood pressure taken, but NOT a blood pressure reading) and completing a survey both before and after the service.

If you would like to take part, it would be very helpful if you could arrive approximately 30 minutes before the start of the service, to ensure that you have plenty of time to ask any questions you might have and to complete the pressure cuff test and survey before the service begins.



## VISITORS' INFO

Children and young people are especially welcome at our services, and there are groups for children and young people in Harwell, and for primary aged and pre-school children in Chilton, along with a family area in both churches.

At our services of Holy Communion all who love the Lord are welcome to share with us. If you require a gluten-free wafer please indicate this to the sidespeople before the service.

Both churches have a hearing loop, and large print service and weekly noticesheets are available. Toilets are at the back of the church in Harwell and accessed from outside at Chilton.
