ELECTORAL ROLL

The Electoral Rolls for St Matthew's Harwell and All Saints' Chilton are being **completely renewed** in the period 17th February to 2nd March 2019 inclusive. The Electoral Roll is your Parish Church's Register of electors, the list of those qualified to vote at the Church Annual General Meeting, at which the Parochial Church Council and Deanery Synod representatives are elected.

If you would like to be on the electoral roll, please complete the relevant forms, (which will be placed with the Electoral Rolls in church), and place them in the box or folder indicated. (The wall safe in Harwell)

Even if you are already on the Electoral Roll, you have to complete a new form.

The church will store contact details of those in the electoral roll in a secure database for legal purposes, and also to enable us to be in touch with relevant church news. Please let us know if you do not want to be contacted.

For both churches, newly completed forms should be returned, **no later than 16th February.**

Continually growing means we regularly reach capacity at Chilton Fledgelings which is why after February half term holiday we are starting a new


WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON FLEDGELINGS!
