

CHRISTIANS AGAINST POVERTY



Some people may be aware either directly from CAP or from the news that as from Friday 9th August, CAP is closed to all new referrals until February 2020. This is so that the HQ teams can catch up with a back log of case work to ensure that they can continue to provide an excellent

service to all of their clients - as well as to implement some reorganisation and updating to ensure they are fit for the future. This will not impact our local Debt Centre too much, as it will give us a chance to catch up and support existing clients. The Trustees had already agreed for the Centre Manager, Sue Bright, to take a month's sabbatical this autumn. It will also allow us to plan and publicise for 2020.

However, please be assured that both as a Debt Centre and with our partner churches we will continue to offer help and support to anyone in debt. We will also be able to point people to other services that could help in the short term or until CAP headquarters can start accepting more clients again. So if you are struggling with debt or know people who are, please do get them to talk to us.

Do please continue to support, serve and pray for our Centre and its clients, and pray for CAP headquarters as they catch up and plan for the future to have an even bigger impact for the Lord in our country.
